SUBJECT: NFPA 1951 ROP TCC FINAL Ballot Results (F2011)

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The Final Results of the NFPA 1951 ROP TCC Letter Ballot are as follows:

20 Members Eligible to Vote

#### PART 1 (TCC Notes)

18 Affirmative (1 affirmative with comment – Stull)  
1 Negatives (Curtis)  
1 Abstentions (Lumry)

#### PART 2 (Release of ROP)

19 Affirmative  
0 Negatives  
1 Abstentions (Lumry)

There are two criteria necessary to pass ballot [(1) affirmative  $\frac{3}{4}$  vote and (2) simple majority].

- (1) The number of affirmative votes needed for the proposal/comment to pass is 15.  
(20 eligible to vote - 0 not returned - 1 abstentions =  $19 \times 0.75 = 14.25$ )
- (2) In all cases, an affirmative vote of at least a simple majority of the total membership eligible to vote is required. This is the calculation for simple majority:  
[20 eligible  $\div 2 = 10 + 1 = (11)$ ]

According to the final ballot results, all ballot items received the necessary  $\frac{3}{4}$  required affirmative votes to pass ballot.


