A **success** certificate will be presented to a person whose actions learned as direct result of participation in NFPA's *Risk Watch*, *Learn Not to Burn*, *Remembering When* or *Fire Prevention Week* program have reduced the danger of a potentially harmful situation.

NFPA will review the information you provide and evaluate it using a rubric evaluation tool to determine if it is a save or a success.
