Pursuant to Section 5 of the NFPA Regulations Governing Committee Projects, the National Fire Protection Association has issued the following Tentative Interim Amendment to NFPA 1500, *Standard on Fire Department Occupational Safety and Health Program*, 2007 edition. The TIA was processed by the Technical Committee on Fire Service Occupational Safety and Health, and was issued by the Standards Council on October 28, 2008, with an effective date of November 17, 2008.

A Tentative Interim Amendment is tentative because it has not been processed through the entire standards-making procedures. It is interim because it is effective only between editions of the standard. A TIA automatically becomes a proposal of the proponent for the next edition of the standard; as such, it then is subject to all of the procedures of the standards-making process.

1. *Revise 7.19.3 to read as follows:*

~~Members' protective ensembles for structural fire fighting and protective ensembles for proximity fire fighting shall be retired in accordance with NFPA 1851, Standard on Selection, Care, and Maintenance of Protective Ensembles for Structural Fire Fighting and Proximity Fire Fighting. PPE shall be taken out of service after 15 years from date of manufacture, regardless of testing or inspection procedures.~~
