Pursuant to Section 5 of the NFPA Regulations Governing Committee Projects, the National Fire Protection Association has issued the following Tentative Interim Amendment to NFPA 1901, *Standard for Automotive Fire Apparatus*, 2009 edition. The TIA was processed by the Technical Committee on Fire Department Apparatus, and was issued by the Standards Council on August 6, 2009, with an effective date of August 26, 2009.

A Tentative Interim Amendment is tentative because it has not been processed through the entire standards-making procedures. It is interim because it is effective only between editions of the standard. A TIA automatically becomes a proposal of the proponent for the next edition of the standard; as such, it then is subject to all of the procedures of the standards-making process.

*1. Add a new section 19.6.4.6 to read as follows:*

**19.6.4.6** For ladders that have a waterway design that allows the monitor to be connected to different ladder sections, a secondary means, not requiring operator intervention, shall be provided to prevent the monitor from being ejected from the ladder.
