## Standard on Protective Ensembles for Structural Fire Fighting and Proximity Fire Fighting

Pursuant to Section 5 of the NFPA Regulations Governing Committee Projects, the National Fire Protection Association has issued the following Tentative Interim Amendment to NFPA 1971, *Standard on Protective Ensembles for Structural Fire Fighting and Proximity Fire Fighting*, 2007 edition. The TIA was processed by the Technical Committee on Structural and Proximity Fire Fighting Protective Clothing and Equipment, and was issued by the Standards Council on March 15, 2007, with an effective date of April 4, 2007.

A Tentative Interim Amendment is tentative because it has not been processed through the entire standards-making procedures. It is interim because it is effective only between editions of the standard. A TIA automatically becomes a proposal of the proponent for the next edition of the standard; as such, it then is subject to all of the procedures of the standards-making process.

1. *Delete 7.1.19 as follows:*

~~[Garment outer shells and collar linings shall be individually tested for strength after washing as specified in Section 8.50, Breaking Strength Test and shall have a breaking strength of not less than 623 N (140 lbf)].~~

2. *Renumber 7.1.20 through 7.1.24 as 7.1.19 through 7.1.23.*

3. *Add new 7.2.4 to read:*

Garment outer shells and collar linings shall be individually tested for strength after washing as specified in Section 8.50, Breaking Strength Test, and shall have a breaking strength of not less than 623 N (140 lbf).
