Standard on Protective Clothing and Equipment for Wildland Fire Fighting

Pursuant to Section 5 of the NFPA Regulations Governing Committee Projects, the National Fire Protection Association has issued the following Tentative Interim Amendment to NFPA 1977, *Standard on Protective Clothing and Equipment for Wildland Fire Fighting*, 2005 edition. The TIA was processed by the Wildland Fire Fighting Protective Clothing and Equipment Committee, and was issued by the Standards Council on January 26, 2006, with an effective date of February 14, 2006.

A Tentative Interim Amendment is tentative because it has not been processed through the entire standards-making procedures. It is interim because it is effective only between editions of the standard. A TIA automatically becomes a proposal of the proponent for the next edition of the standard; as such, it then is subject to all of the procedures of the standards-making process.

Modify paragraph 8.23.7.3 to read as follows:

8.23.7.3 Cut resistance shall be performed under a load of 100 g (3.5 ounces).
