**RV/Park Trailer Revision to
24 C.F.R. 3282.8(g)**

24 C.F.R. 3282.8(g) shall be amended to read as follows:

(g) *Recreational Vehicles and Recreational Park Trailers.*

(1) Recreational vehicles are not subject to the Act. A recreational vehicle is a vehicle that is either:

- (i) Self propelled; or
- (ii) Meets the following conditions:
 - (A) Regulated by the National Highway Traffic and Safety Administration as a vehicle or vehicle equipment;
 - (B) Designed and marketed primarily not for use as permanent dwelling but as a vehicle providing temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, travel, or seasonal use;
 - (C) Built, at a minimum, to the ANSI/NFPA 1192 Standard on Recreational Vehicles, 2005 edition; and
 - (D) Mounted on or permanently towable by another vehicle on the highways without a special highway use permit.

(2) Recreational park trailers are not subject to this part, part 3280, part 3284, or part 3285. A park trailer is a unit that is:

- (i) Designed and marketed primarily not for use as permanent dwelling but as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, travel, or seasonal use;
- (ii) Between 320 and 400 square feet based on the exterior dimensions of the structure measured at the largest horizontal projections, when erected on site including all space which has a ceiling height of more than 5 feet and any expandable room, slide-out, tip-out, or tag-along unit;
- (iii) Not designed to accept additional structures, add-ons or other additions that will increase the area as determined in paragraph (ii) in excess of 400 square feet;
- (iv) Built pursuant to a third party inspection and certification process; and
- (v) Built, at a minimum, to the ANSI A119.5 Recreational Park Trailer Standard, 2005 edition.
