 - A. Elevators
 - i. C. Jennings gave an update on his call with S. Weiss-Ishai
 - As of October there wasn't any education for fire service
 - Elevators were designed to work without fire service intervention
 - C. Jennings will reach out again for updates
 - ii. J. Pauls mentioned there are a number of videos available on his website regarding elevators (www.bldguse.com)
 - iii. There was an article in the Q4 2017 Edition of SFPE's Fire Protection Engineering Magazine
 - V. Boutin will follow up and see if a copy of the article "A Case Study in Occupant Evacuation Elevators" can be made available to the committee
 - iv. C. Jennings will lead the group
 - J. Miller, P. Weismantle, G. Craighead volunteered to help
 - B. Building Under Construction
 - i. A number of proposed changes
 - · Not all are specific to high-rise
 - · Identified the five that are specific to high-rise
 - Will continue to finalize wording for proposed changes
 - Will be finalized by October 2018
 - The committee will be balloted on the high-rise specific changes
 - Those that pass will be submitted by J. Quiter on behalf of the committee
 - Someone from the group can submit the other recommendations not specific to high-rise but the proposal will not come from the entire committee
 - ii. The group would also like to do a Construction EAP
 - Could potentially start by October
 - Will only begin once the code change proposals are complete

- The Construction EAP will include:
 - Fire Risk Assessment
 - All Hazard
 - Temporary Accommodations
 - Response for Major Events
 - Fires
 - Flooding
 - Bombs/Package
 - Environmental Impacts
 - Medical Emergency

- A. Committee decided to submit public inputs for NFPA 101
 - Final version of proposal will be circulated
 - ii. Will have a teleconference in late April or early May to finalize proposals
 - iii. Committee will be balloted
