Following the publication of the Motions Committee’s Report on Certified Amending Motions (CAMs), NFPA received requests from:

- Submitter Julie R. Miller, Health Devices Group, requested to withdraw CAMs 99-7 and 99-9 respectively from consideration during the 2020 NFPA Technical Meeting. The Motions Committee, having authority on such requests, voted to approve these requests for withdrawal. Based upon the results, CAMs 99-7 and 99-9 will not be available for action.
- Submitter Alan Perdue, Safer Buildings Coalition, requested to withdraw CAM 101-16 from consideration during the 2020 NFPA Technical Meeting. The Motions Committee, having authority on such requests, voted to approve this request for withdrawal. Based upon the results, CAM 101-16 will not be available for action.
- Submitter John Woestman, Kellen Company, requested to withdraw CAMs 101-18 and 101-19 respectively from consideration during the 2020 NFPA Technical Meeting. The Motions Committee, having authority on such requests, voted to approve these requests for withdrawal. Based upon the results, CAMs 101-18 and 101-19 will not be available for action.
- Submitter Alan Perdue, Safer Buildings Coalition, requested to withdraw CAM 5000-8 from consideration during the 2020 NFPA Technical Meeting. The Motions Committee, having

authority on such requests, voted to approve this request for withdrawal. Based upon the results, CAM 5000-8 will not be available for action.

As a result of the Motions Committee action withdrawing CAM 5000-8, NFPA 5000®, *Building Construction and Safety Code*, is now a consent standard in accordance with the *Regulations Governing the Development of NFPA Standards*. A consent standard is not presented at the NFPA Technical Meeting but is rather forwarded directly to the Standards Council for issuance. NFPA 5000® has now been added to the list of Consent Standards for the Annual 2020 Revision Cycle.
