What are the registration types?

There is only one type available — General Admission for \$98.00 (Please note the conference series is not offering special NFPA member pricing.)

When will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

A confirmation of your registration will be sent to you via email immediately upon registering from InEvent (our virtual platform provider). A few days before the event, you will receive an additional email with directions for logging in and additional helpful information to make your viewing experience the best it can be.

What if I miss a session or a portion of a session?

If you miss a portion of a session or would like to access the content on demand, it will be available the day after the live event and will remain available to access for one year.

Do I need to sign up for specific sessions in advance?

You can build your schedule in advance, but you can also join any session on the same day of the session. You can also leave one session for another if that is your preference.

Will I receive CEUs for the sessions I attend?

Yes. For sessions offering CEUs, there will be an icon on the bottom right-hand side of the screen that says "CEUs." You will need to click the link and fill out the session survey. Upon completion a certificate will be emailed to you with the session credits.

Can I have a refund?

All sales are non-refundable. If you cannot attend the event you may transfer your ticket to another person or view the content on demand at a later date — up to a year post show.
