Introductions, agenda, approval of minutes, and update on NFPA process

Ed Plaucher called the meeting to order at 8:30AM on Day Mon March 31, 2014, reviewed the meeting Agenda and facilitated committee introductions and commented on:

- NFPA has requested that we participate in a research project situational awareness for firefighters in the Wildland Urban Interface. Purpose of the grant request is to research the potential for taking technology off the shelf to support wildland firefighters. They have requested this committee be represented in the advisory structure for that effort.
- NFPA conducted two technology focused meetings last week and this committee was referenced and/or represented at both.

Jonathan briefed committee on the National Fire Operations Reporting System (NFORS). This is all of the data from the field regarding operational response. It is intended to pick up where NFIRs leaves off.
