Consent Document

NFPA 1194

The Committee on Recreational Vehicles produced a First Revision Report for NFPA 1194, *Standard for Recreational Vehicle Parks and Campgrounds*, and sought Public Comments. No Public Comments were received on this Standard and the Committee determined, through a letter ballot, that a meeting should not be held to consider the development of Second Revisions. Therefore, the proposed NFPA Standard, as revised in the First Draft Report, shall be considered a consent document. According to 4.4.8.4 of the *Regulations Governing the Development of NFPA Standards*, NFPA 1194 will be forwarded directly to the Standards Council for action in accordance with Section 4.7.

NOTE: *In accordance with 1.6.2(a) of the Regs, there is a fifteen day appeal period following the publication date of this report in which one may file an appeal related to the issuance of any Consent Document listed in this report. The final date to file any such appeal is August 2, 2016.*
