Pursuant to Section 5 of the NFPA *Regulations Governing the Development of NFPA Standards*, the National Fire Protection Association has issued the following Tentative Interim Amendment to NFPA 1582, *Standard on Comprehensive Occupational Medical Program for Fire Departments*, 2018 edition. The TIA was processed by the Technical Committee on Fire Service Occupational Safety and Health, and was issued by the Standards Council on November 18, 2017, with an effective date of December 8, 2017.

A Tentative Interim Amendment is tentative because it has not been processed through the entire standards-making procedures. It is interim because it is effective only between editions of the standard. A TIA automatically becomes a public input of the proponent for the next edition of the standard; as such, it then is subject to all of the procedures of the standards-making process.

1. *Revise 7.7.7.4 and add associated Annex A material to read as follows:*

7.7.7.4* The Framingham Heart Study 2-year ACC/AHA Heart Risk Calculator risk prediction score sheets shall be used to generate a 2-year risk of ASCVD, ~~taking into consideration~~ using all of the factors described in 7.7.7.3 except race.
