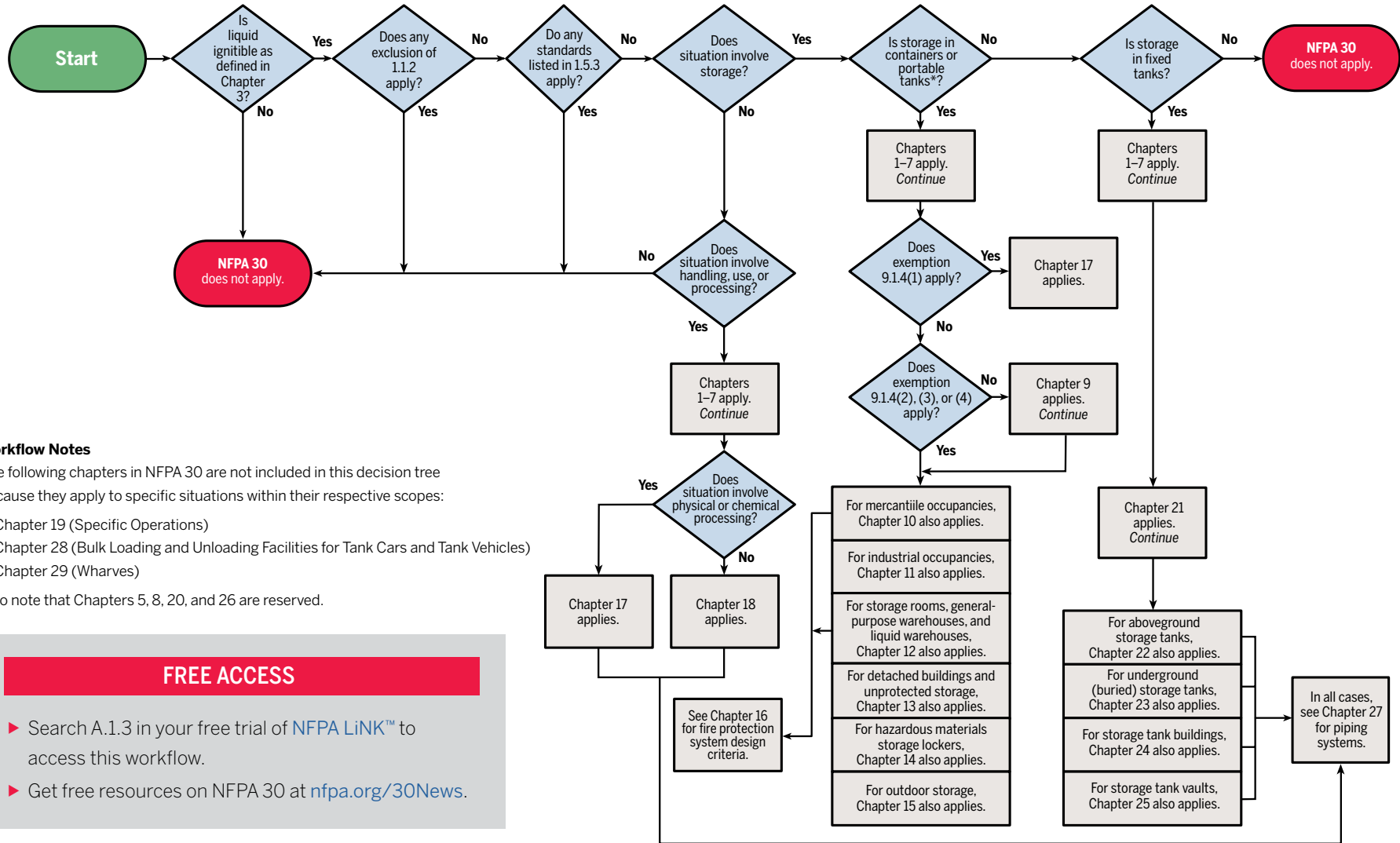




NAVIGATING NFPA® 30

This quick reference guide can help determine which chapters of NFPA 30, *Flammable and Combustible Liquids Code*, 2021 edition, may apply in any given situation.



Workflow Notes

The following chapters in NFPA 30 are not included in this decision tree because they apply to specific situations within their respective scopes:

- Chapter 19 (Specific Operations)
- Chapter 28 (Bulk Loading and Unloading Facilities for Tank Cars and Tank Vehicles)
- Chapter 29 (Wharves)

Also note that Chapters 5, 8, 20, and 26 are reserved.
